To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Houston County, to authorize a person to be elected or appointed as judge of probate of the county who is not over the age of 75 at the time of qualifying for

- 9 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution 10 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:
- 11 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Notwithstanding the provision of Section 155 of the

Constitution of Alabama of 2022, a person who is not over the


age of 75 at the beginning time of qualifying for election, or

at the time of his or her appointment, may be elected or

appointed to the Office of Judge of Probate of Houston County.

Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise internal or external citations and cross-references; and translate effective dates.
