SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, certain items offered for sale in this state must be stored in a manner in which they are not openly available to customers.

This bill would require that hypodermic needles and syringes offered for retail sale be stored in a manner in which they are only accessible by authorized personnel.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to public health; to require hypodermic needles and syringes offered for retail sale be stored in a manner in which they are not openly available to consumers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may cited as the Jace Waters Law.

Section 2. (a) Any hypodermic needle or syringe held or offered for retail sale in this state shall be stored in manner so as to only be accessible by authorized personnel or otherwise not openly available to consumers.

(b) A violation of this section is a Class C
