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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, one percent of the gross
9 amount collected on the \$.10, on each \$100 of the
10 assessed value of taxable property for the relief
11 of needy Confederate soldiers and sailors, resident
12 citizens of the state and their widows, is expended
13 by the Alabama Historical Commission for capital
14 improvements and maintenance at the Confederate
15 Memorial Park at Mountain Creek, Chilton County.

16 This bill would provide for the one percent
17 gross amount collected on the \$.10 on each \$100 of
18 the assessed value of taxable property to be
19 allocated to the Alabama Medicaid Agency.

25 To amend Section 40-8-3 of the Code of Alabama 1975,
26 relating to the allocation of certain proceeds of a state ad
27 valorem tax to the Alabama Historical Commission for the

1 Confederate Memorial Park at Mountain Creek; to provide for
2 the allocation to be allocated to the Alabama Medicaid Agency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. Section 40-8-3 of the Code of Alabama
5 1975, is amended to read as follows:

6 "§40-8-3.

7 "There is hereby levied for the purpose and upon the
8 property hereinafter named and not specifically exempted from
9 taxation annual taxes, as follows:

10 (1) For the maintenance of the public schools of
11 this state, \$.30 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable
12 property.

13 "(2) For the relief of needy Confederate soldiers
14 and sailors, resident citizens of Alabama and their widows,
15 \$.10 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable property of
16 which one percent of the gross amount collected will be
17 ~~expended by the Alabama Historical Commission to provide for~~
18 ~~capital improvements and maintenance at the Confederate~~
19 ~~Memorial Park at Mountain Creek, Chilton County, Alabama~~
20 allocated to the Alabama Medicaid Agency.

21 "(3) For the use of the state and to raise revenue
22 therefor, \$.25 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable
23 property."

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective
25 immediately following its passage and approval by the
26 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
