21	(1) WHOLESALE DEALER AND JOBBER. Persons, firms, or
22	corporations who buy tobacco products direct from the

24	wholesale only, any one or more of the articles taxed herein
25	to licensed wholesale dealers, jobbers, semijobbers, and
26	retail dealers for the purpose of resale only.
27	(2) RETAILER RETAIL DEALER. Every person, firm, or
28	corporation, other than a wholesale dealer or jobber, who

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shall sell or offer for sale any one or more of the articles taxed herein, irrespective of quantity or amount, or the number of sales; and all persons operating under a retail

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dealer's license.

- (3) SEMIJOBBER. Persons, firms, or corporations who buy tobacco products from permitted wholesalers or obtain tobacco from any other source and sell at wholesale any one or more of the articles taxed herein to licensed retail dealers for the purpose of resale only.
- 38 (4) STAMPS. The stamp or stamps by the use of which the 39 tax levied under this article is paid and shall be designated 40 Alabama Revenue Stamps.

 whether the tobacco is pure or flavored, adulterated or mixed
 with any other ingredient, if the roll has a wrapper made
 wholly or in part of tobacco.
 - (6) HEATED TOBACCO PRODUCT. A product containing tobacco that produces an inhalable aerosol by heating the tobacco by means of a device without combustion of the tobacco or by heat generated from a combustion source that only or primarily heats rather than burns the tobacco. It does not include cigarettes or smoking tobacco."
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on October 1, 2024.
