A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A USS COLORADO LICENSE PLATE
102 FOR MOTOR VEHICLES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill creates the USS Colorado license plate. In addition to the normal motor vehicle fees, the plate requires 2 one-time fees of \$25. One of the fees is credited to the highway users tax fund and the other to the licensing services cash fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-213, **amend** (1)
3 (a) (XXV) and (1) (a) (XXVI); and **add** (1) (a) (XXVII) and (28) as
4 follows:

5 **42-3-213. Special plates - military veterans - rules - retirement.**

6 (1) (a) The department shall issue one or more sets of special license
7 plates to the following persons who own a truck that does not exceed
8 sixteen thousand pounds empty weight, a passenger car, a motorcycle, or
9 a noncommercial or recreational vehicle:

10 (XXV) An honorably discharged, retired, reserve, or active
11 member of the Navy SEALs; ~~or~~

12 (XXVI) A natural person who supports the civil air patrol; OR

13 (XXVII) A NATURAL PERSON WHO SUPPORTS THE USS
14 COLORADO.

15 (28) **USS Colorado.** (a) THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS
16 MAY DESIGN THE USS COLORADO LICENSE PLATE IF THE DESIGN
17 CONFORMS WITH STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE
18 PLATE MUST INDICATE THAT AN OWNER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO WHICH
19 THE PLATE IS ATTACHED SUPPORTS THE USS COLORADO SUBMARINE.

20 (b) A NATURAL PERSON WHO SUPPORTS THE USS COLORADO MAY
21 USE USS COLORADO LICENSE PLATE.

22 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -**

23 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
24 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
25 general assembly (August 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7,
26 2014); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1

1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
2 or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
3 will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
4 to be held in November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the
5 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

6 (2) This act applies to applications submitted on or after January
7 1, 2015.
