SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-302.5, **add** (8) as follows:

24-75-302.5. Controlled maintenance - trust fund. (8) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary, on July 1, 2014, the state treasurer shall deduct nine million six hundred seventy-two thousand dollars from the trust fund and transfer such sum to the general fund for the purpose of supporting a fiscal year 2014-15 appropriation for the
