AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF MAXIMIZING MEDICAID AND OTHER FUNDING FOR HEALTH CARE NEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Commissioner of Social
- 2 Services shall study ways to maximize Medicaid funding and other state
- and federal funding sources to address gaps in health care services in
- 4 the state. The study shall include, but need not be limited to, how best
- 5 to ensure adequate funding for (1) remote fetal monitoring, (2) peer
- 6 support services for persons being treated for substance use disorder,
- 7 (3) services for uninsured victims of violence, and (4) Medicaid waiver
- 8 program services for terminally ill children with severe health
- 9 challenges, including rare genetic conditions.
- 10 (b) Not later than December 1, 2024, the commissioner shall file a
- 11 report on the study, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a
- of the general statutes, with the joint standing committee of the General
- 13 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to human services.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
