A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To provide that future elections for the office of coroner of Wheeler County shall be

- 2 nonpartisan elections; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal
- 3 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 All elections for the office of coroner of Wheeler County conducted after the effective date
- 7 of this Act shall be nonpartisan elections as provided for in Code Section 21-2-139 of the
- 8 O.C.G.A. and shall be conducted at the nonpartisan general election immediately preceding
- 9 the expiration of each respective term of office. Such nonpartisan elections shall be held and
- 10 conducted as provided in Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."
- SECTION 2.
- 12 Nothing in this Act shall affect the term of office of the coroner of Wheeler County in office
- on the effective date of this Act. The sitting coroner shall serve out the term of office for
- 14 which such coroner was elected and shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself as
- 15 provided in this Act.
- SECTION 3.
- 17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 18 without such approval.
- 19 **SECTION 4.**
- 20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
