## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to justification and excuse, so as to repeal the statute relating to no duty to retreat
- 3 prior to the use of force and to correct a cross-reference; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 justification and excuse, is amended by repealing Code Section 16-3-23.1, relating to no duty
- 9 to retreat prior to the use of force in self-defense.

SECTION 2.

- 11 Said article is further amended by revising Code Section 16-3-24.2, relating to immunity
- 12 from prosecution, as follows:
- 13 "16-3-24.2.
- A person who uses threats or force in accordance with Code Section 16-3-21, 16-3-23,
- 15 <del>16-3-23.1,</del> or 16-3-24 shall be immune from criminal prosecution therefor unless in the use
- of deadly force, such person utilizes a weapon the carrying or possession of which is
- unlawful by such person under Part 2 or 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of this title."
- 18 SECTION 3.
- 19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- without such approval.
- SECTION 4.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
