A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 25 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Georgia Technology Authority, so as to require the implementation of a state-wide website
- 3 for all individuals, businesses, and legal entities to upload documentation in support of
- 4 applications and submissions to state agencies; to require state agencies to utilize such
- 5 website in reviewing applications and other submissions; to provide for applicability; to
- 6 provide for rules and regulations; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 7 and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 9 SECTION 1.
- 10 Chapter 25 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Georgia
- 11 Technology Authority, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 12 "50-25-17.
- 13 (a) By January 1, 2025, the authority shall create and maintain a state-wide centralized
- 14 website for all individuals, businesses, and legal entities to upload any such documentation
- as may be required by any state agency.

16 (b) All officers and units of state and local government shall, when reviewing any

- 17 <u>application or other submission of any individual, business, or legal entity for any permit,</u>
- license, or any other request for government action, access the website required by
- 19 <u>subsection (a) of this Code section for any documentation required to be submitted in</u>
- 20 <u>support of such application or other submission.</u>
- 21 (c) This Code section shall be broadly construed to apply to:
- 22 (1) All departments, agencies, boards, bureaus, commissions, authorities, and other units
- of state government, by whatever name called; and
- 24 (2) All officers, officials, employees, and agents of the state and such units of state
- 25 government, by whatever name called.
- 26 (d) The authority shall promulgate rules and regulations as necessary to implement the
- 27 provisions of this Code section."

28 SECTION 2.

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
