A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions regarding the maintenance of public roads, so as to require the
- 3 Department of Transportation to remove all trees in the public right of way that are capable
- 4 of falling on an interstate or limited-access highway; to provide for the department to
- 5 designate the removal of trees by a third party after a competitive bidding process; to provide
- 6 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 general provisions regarding the maintenance of public roads, is amended by adding a new
- 11 Code section to read as follows:
- 12 <u>"32-6-6.</u>
- 13 (a) The General Assembly recognizes that traffic often moves at speeds in excess of 55
- miles per hour when traveling on interstates or limited-access roads in this state. In order
- to protect the safety of the traveling public from hazardous conditions caused by fallen
- trees on roadways, all trees located in the public right of way that are capable of falling
- onto any portion of the main traveled way of an interstate or limited-access highway in this
- state shall be removed by the department or a third party designated by the department.
- 19 (b) After a determination by the department or a third party designated by the department
- 20 that a tree on the public right of way is as close to the main traveled way of an interstate
- 21 <u>or limited-access highway as it is tall, the department shall take action to remove the tree</u>
- 22 <u>as soon as practicable.</u>
- 23 (c) The department may designate a third party to remove a tree as described in
- 24 <u>subsection (b) of this Code section after utilizing a competitive bidding process. Such bids</u>
- 25 <u>shall include consideration of the appraised value of the tree to be removed and the resale</u>
- 26 <u>value such tree may have as timber."</u>
