A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Dominique Anthony Turner and dedicating an intersection in his
2 memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Dominique Anthony Turner was a wire technician and installer for AT&T
4 for over ten years; and

5 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Turner was an active member of The Enon
6 Church, where he served as an usher; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Turner's life was tragically cut short when he was struck by a suspected
8 drunk driver just three days after his thirty-ninth birthday; and

9 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
10 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

11 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
12 Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in his memory.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
14 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 92 and Jones Road in Fulton
15 County is dedicated as the Dominique Turner Memorial Intersection.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
17 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Dominique Turner Memorial
18 Intersection.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
20 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
21 family of Mr. Dominique Anthony Turner and to the Department of Transportation.
