- 15 Filosi, Will Britain, Devin Kane, and Malik McNeil all made waves by winning and scoring
- bonus points as they each secured a spot in the finals; and
- 17 WHEREAS, at 120 pounds, J.R. Salemi would set the tone for the Bears, scoring a major
- decision and smashing his way to his second individual state title; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Brandon Filosi left it all on the mat with a hard fought 5-2 victory as the second
- 20 state champion of the night to be crowned, and the Bears moved into first place in the team
