## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 15-18-14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to appointment of assistant district attorneys, qualifications, and compensation, so as to provide for the appointment of additional assistant district attorneys in judicial circuits with multiple detention facilities; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Code Section 15-18-14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to appointment 9 of assistant district attorneys, qualifications, and compensation, is amended by adding a new 10 paragraph to subsection (a) to read as follows: 11 "(3) Subject to the provisions of this Code section and subject to such funds as may be 12 appropriated by the General Assembly or that are otherwise available to this state for such 13 purpose, the district attorney in each judicial circuit shall appoint one additional assistant 14 district attorney for every three detention facilities, as defined in Code Section 35-3-160. 15 or juvenile detention facilities, as defined in Code Section 49-4A-1, or any combination 16 thereof, in his or her judicial circuit."
