A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 12-2-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 promulgation of minimum standards and procedures for protection of natural resources,
- 3 environment, and vital areas of the state, so as to provide flexibility for establishing
- 4 watershed protection standards; to require submission of watershed protection plans by local
- 5 governments; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 12-2-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to promulgation of
- 10 minimum standards and procedures for protection of natural resources, environment, and
- vital areas of the state, is amended by revising subsection (d) as follows:
- 12 "(d) The minimum standards and procedures for watershed protection referred to in
- subsection (b) of this Code section shall specifically include, but shall not be limited to,
- buffer areas along streams and reservoirs, land development densities, and land use
- activities. Local governments shall submit for approval by the department a watershed
- protection plan which shall include watershed protection standards and procedures. The
- 17 department may adopt differing minimum standards and procedures of watershed
- protection based on the size of the watershed, the size or flow volume of the stream or
- reservoir, and whether or not the actual use of the municipal water supply is existing or
- proposed. <u>Standards and procedures for buffer areas along streams and reservoirs shall</u>

comply with subsection (b) of this Code section and Code Section 12-7-6."
