A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating and commending Mrs. Peggy Wilson; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, The General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC), founded in 1890, is a
federation of approximately 2,300 women's clubs in the United States, District of Columbia,
and more than a dozen countries around the world that promotes civic improvements through
volunteer service and is the oldest non-denominational, non-partisan, international service
organization of volunteer women in the world; and

WHEREAS, The GFWC honors one clubwoman from each GFWC Region who was chosen
by their individual club to compete at the state, region, and national levels with the Jennie
Award for outstanding commitment to club, community, and family; and

WHEREAS, The GFWC Jennie Award is named in honor of GFWC's founder, Jane Cunningham Croly, who wrote for national newspapers under the pseudonym "Jennie June." The award highlights those extraordinary clubwomen who epitomize her spirit of independence, courage, and persistence in purpose through their roles as volunteers within their clubs, elsewhere in the community, and as members of a family or extended family. Although GFWC has many awards for states and clubs, the GFWC Jennie Award is the only

WHEREAS, The GFWC Georgia / Morrow Civic Woman's Club was originally federated in 1962 (Morrow Junior Woman's Club) and assists with projects for local libraries, children's shelters, women's shelters, senior citizens' centers, arts centers, recycling programs, Habitat for Humanity, and many other programs that support our military, promote public and political awareness, and sponsor scholarships for women to Clayton State University for continuing education; and

WHEREAS, The GFWC Georgia / Morrow Civic Woman's Club selected Mrs. Peggy
Wilson, a member for 32 years, as their 2024 National Jennie Award nominee; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Peggy Wilson was selected as the Georgia Jennie Award Recipient in
August 2023 and the Southern Region Jennie Award Recipient in October 2023 and will
compete nationally during the 2024 GFWC Annual Convention in Chicago, Illinois, in July
2024; and

WHEREAS, we recognize and commend members of The GFWC, The GFWC Georgia, and
The Morrow Civic Woman's Club for their immeasurable contributions to communities in
our state, throughout the nation, and around the world with countless volunteer service
projects to benefit others.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
congratulate and commend Mrs. Peggy Wilson, The GFWC Georgia / Morrow Civic
Woman's Club's 2024 National Jennie Award nominee, and extend best wishes for future
success.
