- 19 diverse communities to address issues of mutual concern; and
- 20 WHEREAS, during his years of serving on important committees such as the House
- 21 Economic Development and Tourism, Banks and Banking, Science and Technology and
- 22 Industry and Labor, he has established himself as a thoughtful, pragmatic statesman who
- 23 continually tries to push for policy capable of improving lives both in his district and
- 24 throughout the state; and
- 25 WHEREAS, his leadership has been recognized by numerous local, state, and national
- 26 organizations that include the Mexican American Legal Defense and Educational Fund,
- 27 Georgia Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, Boy Scouts of America, and Korean American
- 28 Chamber of Commerce, to name just a few; and
