- 2 WHEREAS, International Women's Day is celebrated worldwide on March 8 to recognize

- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body

15 attack on Israel on October 7 and gender-based violence in Ethiopia, Iran, Nigeria, Sudan,

- 16 Ukraine, and around the world, and calls for swift and effective measures to acknowledge,
- 17 prevent, and combat such violence.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of this body reaffirm their commitment to
- 19 promoting gender equality, empowering women and girls, and creating a society where all
- 20 individuals can live free from discrimination and violence.
- 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of this body encourage all Georgians to
- 22 join in the observance of International Women's Day and to support initiatives that advance
- 23 gender equality and women's rights.
- 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 25 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
- press.
