DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-3-23-5; IC 4-4-32.3; IC 4-12-16; IC 8-23-20-25.3; IC 20-27-4-10.

Synopsis: Natural gas vehicle grant program. Establishes the natural gas vehicle grant program within the office of management and budget to award grants of \$5,000 to school corporations and certain municipalities toward the purchase of natural gas vehicles. Makes an appropriation. Repeals the alternative fuel vehicle grant program for local government units. Requires the Indiana department of transportation to amend certain publications and documents concerning general or specific service signs for compressed natural gas fueling stations.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning transportation and to make an appropriation.

14	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "municipality" has the meaning
15	set forth in IC 36-1-2-11.
16	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "natural gas" has the meaning
17	set forth in IC 6-3.1-34.6-3.
18	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "natural gas vehicle" means the
19	following:
20	(1) For a vehicle purchased by a school corporation, a school
21	bus that runs on only natural gas.
22	(2) For a vehicle purchased by a municipality, a motor vehicle
23	that runs on:
24	(A) natural gas; or
25	(B) natural gas and gasoline.
26	Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "qualified purchase" refers to
27	the purchase after June 30, 2014, of a natural gas vehicle by a
28	school corporation or a municipality.
29	Sec. 5. As used in this chapter, "school bus" has the meaning set
30	forth in IC 20-27-2-8.
31	Sec. 6. As used in this chapter, "school corporation" has the
32	meaning set forth in IC 20-18-2-16.
33	Sec. 7. (a) This chapter applies to the following:
34	(1) A school corporation that purchases school buses to
35	provide transportation for students.
36	(2) A municipality with a population of more than five
37	thousand (5,000).
38	(b) This chapter does not apply to a school corporation to the
39	extent that the school corporation enters into a transportation

41	Sec. 8. (a) The budget agency may award a grant under this
42	chapter to a school corporation or municipality that makes a



1	qualifying purchase.
2	(b) The amount of a grant under this chapter is five thousand
3	dollars (\$5,000).
4	(c) A recipient of a grant under this chapter must comply with
5	any guidelines developed by the budget agency under section 9 of
6	this chapter.
7	(d) The budget agency may not award more than:
8	(1) three (3) grants to a school corporation;
9	(2) two (2) grants to a municipality with a population of at
10	least fifteen thousand (15,000); or
11	(3) one (1) grant to a municipality with a population of more
12	than five thousand (5,000) but less than fifteen thousand
13	(15,000).
14	(e) The total amount of grants awarded under this chapter may
15	not exceed five million dollars (\$5,000,000).
16	Sec. 9. The budget agency shall do the following:
17	(1) Adopt guidelines to determine standards for awarding
18	grants under this chapter, including standards for
19	determining whether a natural gas vehicle complies with
20	applicable governmental or other nationally recognized
21	standards.
22	(2) Prepare and supervise the issuance of information to
23	school corporations and municipalities concerning the grant
24	program established under this chapter.
25	(3) Prescribe the form for and regulate the submission of
26	applications for grants under this chapter.
27	(4) Determine an applicant's eligibility for a grant under this

29	Sec. 10. There is appropriated to the budget agency five million
30	dollars (\$5,000,000) from the state general fund to carry out the
