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1	AN ACT relating to worker benefits.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 336 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Hiring party" means a person who hires or enters into a contract with a
7	self-employed worker;
8	(b) "Portable benefit plan" means a benefit plan that is provided by a third-
9	party insurance provider chosen by a self-employed worker and assigned to
10	a beneficiary rather than to an employer or hiring party, including but not
11	limited to:
12	<u>1. Health insurance;</u>
13	2. Unemployment insurance;
14	3. Disability insurance;
15	<u>4. Life insurance; or</u>
16	5. Retirement benefits; and
17	(c) "Self-employed worker" means a person who earns his or her living from
18	an independent pursuit of economic activities, rather than from a separate
19	<u>company or individual.</u>
20	(2) A public or private entity, including an internet or application-based company,
21	may voluntarily contribute funds to a portable benefit plan as a form of
22	compensation to a self-employed worker.
23	(3) Contributions to a portable benefit plan shall not be used as criterion for
24	determining a worker's employment classification.
