7	(c)	The department shall issue a license as an electrician to a provisional license
8		holder who has, prior to the expiration of the one (1) year term of the
9		provisional license:
10		1. Achieved a passing score on all portions of the examination required
11		and administered by the department under subsection (3)(c) of this
12		section;
13		2. Paid to the department the application fee not to exceed fifty dollars
14		(\$50); and
15		3. Paid to the department the examination fee not to exceed the actual cost

17	(d)	If a provisional license holder does not achieve a passing score on all portions
