10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 36:104(A)(7) and (14) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
12	follows:
13	§104. Powers and duties of the secretary of economic development
14	A. In addition to the functions, powers, and duties otherwise vested in the
15	secretary by law, he shall:

17	(7) Make, and publish, and submit electronically an annual report to the
18	governor, and the legislature every member of the legislature, and the Senate
19	Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs, and the
20	House Committee on Commerce concerning the operations of the department,
21	including an overview of each business incentive and assistance program

of the department, and make other reports and recommendations on his own initiative or upon request of the governor, the legislature, or any committee or member thereof. The overview of each business incentive and assistance program administered by the department shall include a brief description of each program's objective and annual activity and performance information including, as applicable, number of applications received, number of new projects, amount of associated certified spending in the state, number of new permanent jobs, number of construction jobs, number of retained permanent jobs, amount of associated capital investment, and amount of incentive awarded.

(14) Notwithstanding other provisions in this Subsection, the secretary of the Department of Economic Development may provide targeted economic development efforts in priority economic development zones. Such targeted programs shall be in addition to programs already in existence or any programs that may have been implemented in these areas by the department under normal circumstances. "Priority economic development zone" means any parish listed as one of the ten parishes with the highest unemployment rates in Louisiana and any municipality listed as one of the twenty-five municipalities with the highest unemployment rates in Louisiana as of July first of any given year and according to statistics compiled by the Louisiana Workforce Commission. The secretary shall submit annually to the House Commerce Committee and the Senate Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs Committee a report detailing actions taken by the department in compliance with this Paragraph.

Section 2. R.S. 51:935 and 2461 are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§935. Information clearinghouse

A: The department shall serve as the information clearinghouse in Louisiana for all data related to economic development, economic modeling, and strategic economic development planning.

B. The department shall develop a master plan for inventorying, identifying, organizing, consolidating, and centralizing access to all appropriate economic development information developed in the public and private sectors in Louisiana. The plan shall include strategies for on-line access to data bases in the department and other departments of government, to applicable university data bases, and to private sector data bases where feasible. All information applicable to economic development modeling, economic development, strategic economic development planning, business trends, employment, construction, infrastructure, technology, university assets, real estate, industrial and office property, business incentives, and tax data should be organized by the clearinghouse for research, modeling, planning, and recruitment purposes.

C. All departments, agencies, boards, and commissions of state government shall cooperate with the clearinghouse in the development of the plan.

D. Such plan shall be submitted to the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs and the House Committee on Commerce no later than March 1, 1996, with recommendations for implementation and annually thereafter with recommendations for improvement.

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§2461. Report of effect of Louisiana Quality Jobs Program Act; application Application deadline

A. The Department of Economic Development shall prepare a report which shall include but not be limited to documentation of new direct jobs created under this Chapter and a fiscal analysis of the costs and benefits of the program to the state. In conducting such cost/benefit analysis, the department shall consider quantitative factors, such as the anticipated level of new tax revenues to the state along with the added cost to the state of providing services, and such other criteria as deemed appropriate by the department. The requirements of this report shall be satisfied if the department submits a biennial report that contains the information listed in this Section. The report shall be submitted to the president of the Senate, the speaker of the House of Representatives, the governor of this state, and the David R. Poynter

1 Legislative Research Library as provided in R.S. 24:772 no later than March first of 2 each year. 3 B. On and after January 1, 2012, no new applications to receive incentive tax 4 credits or rebates under this Chapter shall be approved by the Department of 5 Economic Development. However, an employer which, prior to January 1, 2012, has 6 been approved by the department to receive incentive tax credits or rebates under the 7 program shall continue to receive tax credits or rebates pursuant to the terms of its 8 agreement with the state of Louisiana as long as the employer retains its eligibility. 9 C. The Department of Economic Development shall annually report the 10 number of jobs created pursuant to this Chapter in each parish. 11 Section 3.
