3	6019(A)(3)(b)(i)(cc), 6020(F)(2), 6021(I)(2), 6022(E)(1)(e)(ii), and 6034(D)(1) and
4	to enact R.S. 47:1508(B)(33) and 1524, relative to tax credits; to establish a registry
5	for certain tax credits; to provide relative to agencies required to submit information
6	to the registry; to provide relative to the information which shall be recorded in the
7	registry; to provide for certain requirements and limitations; to provide relative to
8	access to information in the registry; to provide with respect to the confidentiality of
9	certain tax records; to authorize the secretary of the Department of Revenue to share
10	certain tax credit transfer information; to provide relative to the transferability of
11	certain tax credits; to provide relative to the notification of the transfer or sale of
12	certain tax credits; to provide that certain records are private; to provide for an
13	effective date; and to provide for related matters.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
15	Section 1. R.S. 47:6007(C)(4)(b), 6016(F)(1)(b), 6019(A)(3)(b)(i)(cc), 6020(F)(2),
16	6021(I)(2), $6022(E)(1)(e)(ii)$, and $6034(D)(1)$ are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
17	47:1508(B)(33) and 1524 are hereby enacted to read as follows:

1	<u>§1524. Tax credit registry; requirements; limitations</u>
2	A. Purpose. The intent of this Section is to provide for a centralized
3	registration and recordation system for transferable tax credits granted, issued, and
4	authorized by the state of Louisiana. The provisions of this Section shall be known
5	and cited as the "Louisiana Tax Credit Registry Act".
6	B. Definitions. For purposes of this Section, the following words shall have
7	the following meaning unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
8	(1) "Department" means the Department of Revenue.
9	(2) "Identification number" means a unique identifying number that shall be
10	assigned to each tax credit certificate registered in the registry. A tax credit's
11	identification number shall remain associated with the tax credit from the time the
12	credit is originally entered into the registry through any claim, transfer, or refund
13	associated with the credit, until such time as the tax credit is fully redeemed.
14	(3) "Secretary" means the secretary of the Department of Revenue.
15	(4) "Tax credit" means any transferable tax credit granted, issued, and
16	authorized by the state applied against taxes collected by the department.
17	(5) "Tax credit certificate" means any document granting tax credits issued
18	by a state agency administering a tax credit program, including but not limited to tax
19	credit certification letters which shall include the name of the individual or entity
20	issued the tax credit, the amount of the tax credit, and any other identifying
21	information regarding the tax credit.
22	(6) "Transfer" means an assignment, disposition, transfer, or allocation of
23	tax credits.
24	(7) "Transferee" means an individual or entity that receives a transfer of tax
25	credits.
26	(8) "Transferor" means an individual or entity that makes a transfer of tax
27	credits.
28	C. Administration. There is hereby established a central tax credit registry,
29	hereinafter referred to as "registry", within the department for the registration and

1	recordation of tax credits granted, issued, and authorized by the state and any
2	subsequent transfers.
3	(1) Beginning January 1, 2014, all state agencies issuing tax credits to be
4	applied against taxes collected by the department shall promptly send a copy of any
5	newly granted, issued, or authorized tax credit certificates to the department. Upon
6	receipt of this information, the department shall assign an identifying number to each
7	tax credit, and shall record the tax credit into the registry along with the name of the
8	individual or entity issued the tax credit, the amount of the tax credit, and any other
9	information deemed necessary by the secretary.
10	(2) Any state agency that issues or authorizes tax credits shall remit an
11	electronic report on forms prescribed by the secretary no later than January 31, 2014,
12	of all tax credit certificates issued prior to January 1, 2014. The department shall
13	endeavor to record all tax credit transfers which occurred prior to January 1, 2014,
14	into the registry.
15	D. Transfers.
16	(1) Joint notice from the transferor and the transferee of all tax credit
17	transfers shall be submitted to the department, including additional information that
18	the secretary deems necessary and appropriate. Upon receipt of the applicable tax
19	credit information, the department shall record the transfer of the tax credit by
20	recording the applicable identification numbers, the name of the transferor and
21	transferee, the amount of the tax credits being transferred, and any other information
22	deemed necessary by the secretary.
23	(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no issuance
24	or transfer of tax credits after January 1, 2014, shall be effective as to third parties
25	nor recognized by the department until it has been recorded in the registry.
26	(3) The effectiveness of a tax credit transfer as between the transferor and
27	the transferee shall be provided by agreement of the parties or, in the absence of an
28	agreement, in accordance with the provisions of the Louisiana Civil Code and its
29	ancillaries.

1	E. Disallowance and recapture of tax credits. A tax credit shall be
2	disallowed and recaptured if the department or state agency issuing the tax credit
3	finds that an individual or entity obtained a tax credit in violation of the provisions
4	of the statute authorizing issuance of the tax credit, including but not limited to fraud
5	or misrepresentation. Any tax credit previously granted to an individual or entity but
6	later disallowed may be recovered by the secretary pursuant to the provisions of R.S.
7	47:1561. The provisions of this Subsection are in addition to and shall not limit the
8	authority of the secretary of the department to assess, collect, or recapture under any
9	other provision of law.
10	(1) If the transferor of a tax credit did not have the right to claim or use the
11	tax credit at the time of the transfer, the transferee's recourse shall be against the
12	transferor, as provided by agreement of the parties. The department shall warrant the
13	validity of the information recorded in the registry for credits issued after January 1,
14	2014. A good faith transferee, as determined by the department at the time of
15	transfer, that relied on the validity of the credits recorded in the registry shall not be
16	subject to the provisions of this Subsection. For purposes of this Subsection, "good
17	faith" shall mean honesty in fact and the observance of reasonable commercial
18	standards of fair dealing.
19	(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the department may
20	recapture any amounts and other damages from any individual or entity determined
21	not to be in good faith as provided for in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection.
22	F. Prescription. (1) In case of disputed title to tax credits, prescription
23	against assessment shall be suspended by any of the following:
24	(a) The filing of a summary proceeding in any state or federal court.
25	(b) A written agreement between all interested taxpayers and the secretary.
26	(c) The filing of any pleading, either by the secretary or any taxpayer, with
27	the Board of Tax Appeals.
28	(2) Prescription shall begin to run again upon the issuance of a final
29	administrative decision or a judgment that has become final and nonappealable.

1	G. Registry access. Information contained in the registry and in the
2	possession of the department regarding the ownership of tax credits, all transfers of
3	tax credits, and the amount of tax credits shall be deemed privileged and confidential
4	under the provisions of R.S. 47:1508 and shall not be available to the public;
5	however, the provisions of this Subsection shall not be construed to prevent
б	information relative to the entity or individual initially issued the tax credit, the
7	initial amount of the tax credit, and any information regarding any transfer of the tax
8	credit from being released to the public pursuant to a public records request
9	submitted to the state agency administering the tax credit program pursuant to the
10	Public Records Law, R.S. 44:1 et seq. The data compiled in the registry shall be
11	available for cross-referencing by other state agencies; however, state agencies shall
12	apply to the department for access to the registry and shall be subject to any
13	permissions, restrictions, and conditions as determined by the department. Upon
14	application by a transferor, on a form prescribed by the secretary, the department
15	shall provide information sufficient to certify the transferor is the record owner of
16	tax credits issued on or after January 1, 2014, which are registered in the transferor's
17	name in the registry. The secretary shall prescribe the application required by the
18	provisions of this Subsection to be submitted by a transferor to certify the record
19	owner of tax credits.
20	H. Rules. The secretary of the department may promulgate rules and
21	regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act as may be
22	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

1	(4) Transferability of the credit. Any motion picture tax credits not
2	previously claimed by any taxpayer against its income tax may be transferred or sold
3	to another Louisiana taxpayer or to the office, subject to the following conditions:
4	* * *
5	(b) Transferors and transferees shall submit to the office, and to the
6	Department of Revenue in writing, a notification of any transfer or sale of tax credits
7	within thirty ten business days after the transfer or sale of such tax credits. The
8	notification shall include the transferor's tax credit balance prior to transfer, a copy
9	of any tax credit certification letter(s) issued by the office and the secretary of the
10	Department of Economic Development and, the transferor's remaining tax credit
11	balance after transfer, all tax identification numbers for both transferor and
12	transferee, the date of transfer, the amount transferred, a copy of the credit
13	certificate, price paid by the transferee to the transferor, in the case when the
14	transferor is a state-certified production, for the tax credits, and any other
15	information required by the office or the Department of Revenue. For the purpose
16	of reporting transfer prices, the term "transfer" shall include allocations pursuant to
17	Paragraph (2) of this Subsection as provided by rule. The office may post on its
18	website an average tax credit transfer value, as determined by the office and the
19	secretary of the Department of Economic Development to reflect adequately the
20	current average tax credit transfer value. The tax credit transfer value means the
21	percentage as determined by the price paid by the transferee to the transferor divided
22	by the dollar value of the tax credits that were transferred in return. The notification
23	submitted to the office Department of Revenue shall include a processing fee of up
24	to two hundred dollars per transferee, and any pricing information submitted by a
25	transferor or transferee shall be treated by the office and the Department of Revenue
26	as proprietary to the entity reporting such information and therefore confidential.
27	However, this shall not prevent the publication of summary data that includes no
28	fewer than three transactions.

28	transfer, the credit identification number assigned by the state historic preservation
29	office, the remaining balance after transfer, all federal and Louisiana tax

9	previously claimed by any taxpayer against its tax may be transferred or sold to
10	another Louisiana taxpayer, subject to the following conditions:

12	(2) Transferors and transferees shall submit to the department and the
13	Department of Revenue, in writing, a notification of any transfer or sale of tax credits
14	within thirty ten business days after the transfer or sale of such tax credits. The
15	notification shall include the transferor's tax credit balance prior to transfer, a copy
16	of any tax credit certificate issued by the secretary of the Department of Economic
17	Development and, the transferor's remaining tax credit balance after transfer, all tax
18	identification numbers for both transferor and transferee, the date of transfer, the
19	amount transferred, the price paid by the transferee to the transferor, and any other
20	information required by the department or the Department of Revenue. Any pricing
21	information submitted by a transferor or transferee shall be treated by the department
22	and the Department of Revenue as proprietary to the entity reporting such
23	information and therefore confidential. However, this shall not prevent the
24	publication of summary data that includes no fewer than three transactions.

29	Revenue, in writing, a notification of any transfer or sale of tax credits within thirty

10	D.(1) The credit shall be allowed against individual or corporate income tax
11	of the companies or financiers of the production or infrastructure project in
12	accordance with their share of the credit as provided for in the application for
13	certification for the production or infrastructure project. A company or financier
14	may, on a one-time basis, transfer the credit , and/or or any refund of an overpayment ,
15	to an individual or other entity including without limitation a bank or other lender,
16	provided that the transfer shall not be effective until receipt by the Department of
17	Revenue of written notice of such transfer. Transferors and transferees shall submit
18	to the Department of Revenue, in writing, a notification of any transfer of the tax
19	credit within ten business days after the transfer. The credit shall be allowed for the
20	taxable period in which expenditures eligible for a credit are expended. Any excess
21	of the credit over the income tax liability against which the credit may be applied
22	shall constitute an overpayment, as defined in R.S. 47:1621(A), and the secretary of
23	the Department of Revenue shall make a refund of such overpayment from the
24	current collections of the taxes imposed by Chapter 1 of Subtitle II of this Title, as
25	amended. The right to a refund of any such overpayment shall not be subject to the
26	requirements of R.S. 47:1621(B).

11	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
12	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
13	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
14	effective on the day following such approval.
