# BESE: Provides that the conduct of extracurricular interscholastic activities in public schools are subject to BESE regulation by rule adopted in accordance with the APA

2	To enact R.S. 17:176(G), relative to extracurricular interscholastic activities; to provide that
3	the conduct of extracurricular interscholastic activities in public schools shall be
4	subject to regulation by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education by
5	rule adopted in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act; to provide
6	applicability; to provide relative to the precedence of such a rule; to provide an
7	effective date; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 17:176(G) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§176. Extracurricular activities; participation; standards; prohibitions; filming or
11	videotaping

13	G. The conduct of extracurricular interscholastic activities in public schools,
14	including but not limited to the conduct of interscholastic athletic activities in public
15	secondary schools and between a public secondary school and a nonpublic secondary
16	school that is approved by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education,
17	shall be subject to regulation by the state board by rule adopted in accordance with
18	the Administrative Procedure Act. A rule adopted by the board shall have
19	precedence over any regulation to the contrary adopted by an organization,

- 3 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- 4 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

- 6 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 7 effective on the day following such approval.

**Abstract:** Provides that the conduct of extracurricular interscholastic activities in public schools, including interscholastic athletic activities, shall be subject to regulation by BESE by rule adopted in accordance with the APA. Provides precedence for any such rule.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the conduct of extracurricular interscholastic activities in public schools, including but not limited to the conduct of interscholastic athletic activities in public secondary schools and between a public secondary school and a nonpublic secondary school that is approved by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE), shall be subject to regulation by BESE in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.

Specifies that a rule adopted by BESE shall have precedence over any regulation to the contrary adopted by an organization, association, or other group composed of representatives from schools participating in the activity.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
