2	To amend and reenact R.S. 47:2134(B)(1) and (C)(1), relative to taxes paid under protest;
3	to require the taxpayer to submit separate payments for the disputed amount of tax
4	due and the amount that is not in dispute; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 47:2134(B)(1) and (C)(1) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
7	as follows:
8	§2134. Suits to recover taxes paid under protest
9	* * *
10	B.(1) A taxpayer challenging the correctness of an assessment under either
11	R.S. 47:1856, 1857, or 1998 shall timely pay the disputed amount of tax due under
12	protest to the officer or officers designated by law for the collection of this tax. The
13	portion of the taxes that is paid by the taxpayer to the collecting officer or officers
14	that is neither in dispute nor the subject of a suit contesting the correctness of the
15	assessment shall not be made subject to the protest. The taxpayer shall submit
16	separate payments for the disputed amount of tax due and the amount that is
17	not in dispute and not subject to the protest.
18	* * *
19	C.(1) A person resisting the payment of an amount of ad valorem tax due or
20	the enforcement of a provision of the ad valorem tax law and thereby intending to
21	maintain a legality challenge shall timely pay the disputed amount due under protest
22	to the officer or officers designated by law for the collection of the tax and shall give
23	such officer or officers, notice at the time of payment of his intention to file suit for
24	the recovery of the protested tax. The portion of the taxes that is paid by the
25	taxpayer to the collecting officer or officers that is neither in dispute nor the
26	subject of a suit contesting the legality of the assessment shall not be made
27	subject to the protest. The taxpayer shall submit separate payments for the

disputed amount of tax due and the amount that is not in dispute and not

subject to the protest. Upon receipt of a notice, the protested amount shall be
segregated and held by the collecting officer for a period of thirty days.
