An Act relative to leaving the scene of a collision.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "property", in line 726, as appearing in the
- 3 2010 Official Edition, the following words:- "or after having reason to know that he collided
- 4 with or otherwise caused injury to any other vehicle or property,".
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 24 of chapter 90, as appearing in the 2012 edition, is hereby further
- 6 amended by inserting after the word "person", in line 773, as so appearing, the following words:-
- 7 "or after having reason to know that he collided with or otherwise caused injury to any person
- 8 not resulting in the death of any person,".
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 24 of chapter 90, as appearing in the 2012 edition, is hereby further
- amended by striking out, in line 782, as so appearing, the word "shall" and inserting in place
- 11 thereof the following words:- "or after having reason to know that he collided with or otherwise
- 12 caused injury to any person, shall,".
