An Act relative to the charitable donation of not readily marketable food.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 328 of Chapter 94 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2018  
2 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting, in line 1, before the words “No person”, the  
3 following paragraph: -

4           For the purpose of this section, the term "person" shall mean an individual, corporation,  
5 partnership, organization, association, or governmental entity, including a retail grocer,  
6 wholesaler, hotel, motel, manufacturer, restaurant, caterer, farmer, and nonprofit food distributor  
7 or hospital. In the case of a corporation, partnership, organization, association, or governmental  
8 entity, the term includes an officer, director, partner, deacon, trustee, council member, or other  
9 elected or appointed individual responsible for the governance of the entity; as defined by

- 10 Paragraph (10) of Subsection (b) of Section 1791 of Chapter 13A of the 2015 United States
- 11 Code, also known as the Bill Emerson Good Samaritan Food Donation Act.
