1 AN ACT concernin

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Public Safety - Law Enforcement Dogs - Protective Equipment

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a law enforcement agency that uses a certain licensed dog to make available certain protective equipment for use on the dog under certain 4 5 circumstances; providing that the determination whether to have a certain dog use 6 certain equipment under certain circumstances shall be made by the law 7 enforcement agency or the dog's handler; authorizing the Department of State Police 8 to adopt certain regulations; requiring the Department to monitor compliance under 9 this Act and, on or before a certain date each year, make a certain report to the General Assembly; providing the intent of the General Assembly for compliance with 10 11 this Act on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of a certain 12 provision of this Act; and generally relating to law enforcement dogs.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Public Safety
- 21 **3-514.**
- 22 (A) A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT USES A DOG LICENSED BY THE
- 23 DEPARTMENT UNDER § 2–313 OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE A
- 24 PROTECTIVE VEST OR BODY ARMOR FOR USE ON THE DOG IF:

- 1 (1) THE DOG IS ON DUTY AND OPERATING IN A PHYSICALLY 2 THREATENING ENVIRONMENT; AND
- 3 (2) WEARING THE PROTECTIVE VEST OR BODY ARMOR WOULD 4 REDUCE THE RISK OF SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.
- 5 (B) THE DETERMINATION WHETHER TO HAVE A DOG WEAR A PROTECTIVE VEST OR BODY ARMOR UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE MADE BY THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR THE DOG'S HANDLER.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 9 (a) The Department of State Police may adopt regulations to carry out the 10 provisions of this Act.
- 11 (b) The Department shall monitor compliance with this Act and, on or before
- 12 January 1 of each year, report to the General Assembly, in accordance with $\S 2-1246$ of the
- 13 State Government Article, on, with regard to each law enforcement agency subject to this
- 14 Act:
- 15 (1) the total number of dogs licensed by the Department in use by the law 16 enforcement agency;
- 17 (2) the total number of protective vests or body armor needed by the law enforcement agency to comply with this Act; and
- 19 (3) the current number of protective vests or body armor on hand at the 20 law enforcement agency.
- 21 (c) It is the intent of the General Assembly that each law enforcement agency 22 subject to this Act shall be in full compliance with the requirements of this Act on or before 23 January 1, 2018.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- October 1, 2016. Section 2 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at
- 26 the end of September 30, 2019, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
- 27 Section 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
