- questions at the end of a ballot and arrange them in a certain order; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the inclusion of offices and questions for

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Local Government
- 17 **4–108.1.**
- 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE
- 19 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 20 (2) "BALLOT" MEANS A BALLOT PREPARED BY THE STATE BOARD
- 21 OF ELECTIONS UNDER TITLE 9 OF THE ELECTION LAW ARTICLE.
- 22 (3) "STATE BOARD" MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS.

1	(B) A MUNICIPALITY MAY REQUEST THAT THE STATE BOARD INCLUDE
2	ON A BALLOT THE OFFICES AND QUESTIONS TO BE VOTED ON IN A MUNICIPAL
3	ELECTION.

- 4 (C) IF A MUNICIPALITY MAKES A REQUEST UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE BOARD SHALL:
- 6 (1) INCLUDE THE OFFICES AND QUESTIONS AT THE END OF THE 7 BALLOT; AND
- 8 (2) ARRANGE THE OFFICES AND QUESTIONS IN A SIMILAR ORDER 9 AS OTHER OFFICES AND QUESTIONS ARE ARRANGED ON THE BALLOT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
