- a certain date; requiring the Department to report to the Governor and General Assembly certain information and certain recommendations on or before a

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Education
- 19 **6–122.**
- 20 (A) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A 21 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT EVALUATION SYSTEM THAT:
- 22 (1) IS BASED ON TEACHER FEEDBACK THROUGH SURVEYS AND 23 OTHER INTERVIEW TECHNIQUES; AND



(2)	WILL ENABLE THE	COUNTY BOARD TO:
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- 2 (I) ASSESS TEACHER SATISFACTION WITH PROFESSIONAL 3 DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES; AND
- 4 (II) MEASURE THE EFFECTIVENESS AND RELEVANCY OF 5 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES.
- 6 (B) ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH COUNTY BOARD
 7 SHALL REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT THE RESULTS OF ITS PROFESSIONAL
 8 DEVELOPMENT EVALUATION SYSTEM FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR.
- 9 (C) (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE RESULTS RECEIVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 14 **(2)** THE REPORT SUBMITTED UNDER PARAGRAPH **(1)** OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:
- 16 (I) Information regarding the effectiveness and 17 Relevancy of professional development activities in the State; and
- 18 (II) RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE ENHANCEMENT OF
 19 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES THAT MAY INCLUDE THE CREATION
 20 OF STATEWIDE INCENTIVE PROGRAMS TO REWARD LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEMS
 21 THAT MODIFY PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES IN THE COUNTY IN
 22 RESPONSE TO THE RESULTS OF THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT
 23 EVALUATION SYSTEM IN THE COUNTY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
