AN ACT

To repeal section 191.775, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to use of tobacco products in places associated with schools, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 191.775, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 191.775, to read as follows:

191.775. 1. No person shall smoke or otherwise use tobacco or tobacco products in any of the following places:

- (1) Any indoor area of a public elementary or secondary school building or educational facility, excluding institutions of higher education[,];
- (2) Any [or on] buses used solely to transport students to or from school or to transport students to or from any place for educational purposes; or
- (3) Any grounds or outdoor facility areas of a public elementary or secondary school building or educational facility, excluding institutions of higher education.
- 9 2. Any school board of any school district may set policy on the permissible uses of 10 tobacco products in any [other] nonclassroom or nonstudent occupant facility not listed in subsection 1 of this section[, and on the school grounds or outdoor facility areas as the school 12 board deems proper].
- 13 3. Any person who violates the provisions of subsection 1 of this section shall be guilty of an infraction.
