AN ACT

To amend chapter 324, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the medical practice freedom act.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 324, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 324.048, to read as follows:

324.048. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Medical Practice Freedom Act".

2. State licensure requirements for physicians, chiropractors, optometrists, and dentists in this state shall be granted based on demonstrated skill and academic competence. Licensure approval for physicians, chiropractors, optometrists, and dentists in this state shall not be conditioned upon or related to participation in any public or private health insurance plan, public health care system, public service initiative, or emergency room coverage.

9 3. State licensure for physicians, chiropractors, optometrists, and dentists shall be 10 conducted exclusively under chapters 334, 331, 336, and chapter 332, respectively.

4. State licensure for physicians or optometrists shall not be conditioned upon or
related to compliance with the "meaningful use" of electronic health records as set forth
in CFR Part 170.
