JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article X of the Constitution of Missouri, by adding thereto one new section relating to local taxation.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on

- 2 Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2020, or at a special
- 3 election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted
- 4 to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following
- 5 amendment to article X of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article X, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding

2 thereto one new section, to be known as section 27, to read as follows:

Section 27. In any county or other political subdivision which

2 levies a property tax, sales tax, or any other tax solely for a specific

purpose, and whose boundaries overlap the boundaries of another

4 political subdivision which also levies a property tax, sales tax, or any

5 other tax solely for the same purpose, persons residing in such

overlapping boundaries shall only remit such property tax, sales tax,

7 or other tax to one taxing jurisdiction. The local election authority or

8 authorities with jurisdiction over the overlapping boundaries shall

9 submit to the voters living within the overlapping boundaries the

10 question of from which political subdivision such voters shall continue

11 to receive services and to which political subdivision the voters shall

12 remit the tax.
