## A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-3,104.02
2	and 60-3,125, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
3	section 60-3,104.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
4	Supplement, 2012; to change provisions relating to
5	specialty license plates and Purple Heart license plates;
6	and to repeal the original sections.
7	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-3,104.01, Revised Statutes

- 2 Cumulative Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 60-3,104.01 (1) A person may apply for specialty license
- 4 plates in lieu of regular license plates on an application prescribed
- 5 and provided by the department pursuant to section 60-3,104.02 for
- 6 any motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer, except for
- 7 motor vehicles or trailers registered under section 60-3,198. An
- 8 applicant receiving a specialty license plate for a farm truck with a
- 9 gross weight of over sixteen tons or for a commercial motor vehicle
- 10 registered for a gross weight of five tons or over shall affix the
- 11 appropriate tonnage decal to the plate. The department shall make
- 12 forms available for such applications.
- 13 (2) Each application for initial issuance or renewal of
- 14 specialty license plates shall be accompanied by a fee of seventy
- 15 dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted
- 16 to the State Treasurer. The State Treasurer shall credit fifteen
- 17 percent of the such fee for initial issuance and renewal of specialty
- 18 license plates to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and
- 19 eighty-five percent of the such fee to the Highway Trust Fund.
- 20 (3) Each application for initial issuance or renewal of
- 21 specialty license plates for a nationally recognized military
- 22 <u>association shall, in addition to the fee required pursuant to</u>
- 23 subsection (2) of this section, be accompanied by a fee of five
- 24 <u>dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted</u>
- 25 to the State Treasurer. The State Treasurer shall credit such fee to

- 1 <u>the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.</u>
- (2) When the department receives an application for
- 3 specialty license plates, it shall deliver the plates to the county
- 4 treasurer of the county in which the motor vehicle, trailer,
- 5 semitrailer, or cabin trailer is registered. The county treasurer
- 6 shall issue specialty license plates in lieu of regular license
- 7 plates when the applicant complies with the other provisions of law
- 8 for registration of the motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin
- 9 trailer. If specialty license plates are lost, stolen, or mutilated,
- 10 the licensee shall be issued replacement license plates pursuant to
- 11 section 60-3,157.
- 12  $\frac{(3)(a)}{(5)(a)}$  The owner of a motor vehicle, trailer,
- 13 semitrailer, or cabin trailer bearing specialty license plates may
- 14 make application to the county treasurer to have such specialty
- 15 license plates transferred to a motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer,
- 16 or cabin trailer other than the motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer,
- 17 or cabin trailer for which such plates were originally purchased if
- 18 such motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer is owned
- 19 by the owner of the specialty license plates.
- 20 (b) The owner may have the unused portion of the
- 21 specialty license plate fee credited to the other motor vehicle,
- 22 trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer which will bear the specialty
- 23 license plates at the rate of eight and one-third percent per month
- 24 for each full month left in the registration period.
- 25 (c) Application for such transfer shall be accompanied by

1 a fee of three dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection

- 2 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department
- 3 of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
- 4 Sec. 2. Section 60-3,104.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 5 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 6 60-3,104.02 (1) On or before January 1, 2011, the
- 7 department shall begin issuing specialty license plates for any
- 8 organization which certifies that it meets the requirements of this
- 9 section. The department shall work with the organization to design
- 10 the plates.
- 11 (2) The department shall make applications available
- 12 pursuant to section 60-3,104.01 for each type of specialty license
- 13 plate when it is designed.
- 14 (3)(a) Except as provided in subdivision (b) of this
- 15 <u>subsection</u>, <u>the The</u> department shall not manufacture specialty
- 16 license plates for an organization until the department has received
- 17 five hundred prepaid applications for specialty license plates
- 18 designed for that organization. The department may revoke the
- 19 approval for an organization's specialty license plate if the total
- 20 number of registered vehicles that obtained such plate is less than
- 21 five hundred within three years after receiving approval.
- 22 (b) The department shall not manufacture specialty
- 23 <u>license plates for a nationally recognized military association until</u>
- 24 the department has received one hundred fifty prepaid applications
- 25 for specialty license plates designed for that association. The

1 department may revoke the approval for an association's specialty

- 2 <u>license plate if the total number of registered vehicles that</u>
- 3 obtained such plate is less than one hundred fifty within three years
- 4 <u>after receiving approval.</u>
- $\frac{(3)-(4)}{(3)}$  In order to have specialty license plates
- 6 designed and manufactured, an organization shall furnish the
- 7 department with the following:
- 8 (a) A copy of its articles of incorporation and, if the
- 9 organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy
- 10 for each organization;
- 11 (b) A copy of its charter or bylaws and, if the
- 12 organization consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy
- 13 for each organization;
- 14 (c) Any Internal Revenue Service rulings of the
- 15 organization's nonprofit tax-exempt status and, if the organization
- 16 consists of a group of nonprofit corporations, a copy for each
- 17 organization;
- 18 (d) A copy of a certificate of existence on file with the
- 19 Secretary of State under the Nebraska Nonprofit Corporation Act;
- 20 (e) Five hundred prepaid applications for the speciality
- 21 license plates or, for a nationally recognized military association,
- 22 one hundred fifty prepaid applications for the specialty license
- 23 <u>plates</u>; and
- 24 (f) A completed application for the issuance of the
- 25 plates on a form provided by the department certifying that the

- 1 organization meets the following requirements:
- 2 (i) The organization is a nonprofit corporation or a
- 3 group of nonprofit corporations with a common purpose;
- 4 (ii) The primary activity or purpose of the organization
- 5 serves the community, contributes to the welfare of others, and is
- 6 not offensive or discriminatory in its purpose, nature, activity, or
- 7 name;
- 8 (iii) The name and purpose of the organization does not
- 9 promote any specific product or brand name that is on a product
- 10 provided for sale;
- 11 (iv) The organization is authorized to use any name,
- 12 logo, or graphic design suggested for the design of the plates;
- 13 (v) No infringement or violation of any property right
- 14 will result from such use of such name, logo, or graphic design; and
- 15 (vi) The organization will hold harmless the State of
- 16 Nebraska and its employees and agents for any liability which may
- 17 result from any infringement or violation of a property right based
- 18 on the use of such name, logo, or graphic design.
- 19  $\frac{(4)-(5)}{(5)}$  The department may adopt and promulgate rules and
- 20 regulations to carry out this section.
- 21 Sec. 3. Section 60-3,125, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 22 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 23 60-3,125 (1) Any person may, in addition to the
- 24 application required by section 60-385, apply to the department for
- 25 license plates designed by the department to indicate that the

1 applicant has received from the federal government an award of a

- 2 Purple Heart. The inscription of the plates shall be designed so as
- 3 to include a facsimile of the award and beneath any numerical
- 4 designation upon the plates pursuant to section 60-370 the words
- 5 Purple Heart separately on one line and the words Combat Wounded on
- 6 the line below.
- 7 (2) The license plates shall be issued upon payment of
- 8 the regular license fee and an additional fee of five dollars and
- 9 furnishing proof satisfactory to the department that the applicant
- 10 was awarded the Purple Heart. The additional fee shall be remitted to
- 11 the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery
- 12 System Operation Fund. Any number of motor vehicles, trailers,
- 13 semitrailers, or cabin trailers owned by the applicant may be so
- 14 licensed at any one time. Motor vehicles and trailers registered
- under section 60-3,198 shall not be so licensed.
- 16 (3) If license plates issued pursuant to this section are
- 17 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the recipient of the plates shall be
- 18 issued replacement license plates upon request and without charge.
- 19 Sec. 4. Original sections 60-3,104.02 and 60-3,125,
- 20 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 60-3,104.01,
- 21 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012, are repealed.
