LB 790

1 Section 1. To facilitate consistency in training all case 2 managers and allow for Title IV-E reimbursement for case manager training under Title IV-E of the federal Social Security Act, as 3 4 amended, the same program for initial training of case managers shall 5 be utilized for all case managers, whether they are employed by the 6 department or by an organization under contract with the department. 7 The initial training of all case managers shall be provided by the 8 same entity, whether it is the department or an organization under 9 contract with the department. If a contractor is utilized for initial 10 training of case managers, the department shall create a formal system for measuring and evaluating the quality of such training. All 11 12 case managers shall complete a formal assessment process after 13 initial training to demonstrate competency prior to assuming 14 responsibilities as a case manager. The training curriculum for case managers shall include, but not be limited to: (a) An understanding 15 16 of the benefits of utilizing evidence-based and promising casework practices; (b) the importance of guaranteeing service providers' 17 fidelity to evidence-based and promising casework practices; and (c) 18 a commitment to evidence-based and promising family-centered casework 19 20 practices that utilize a least restrictive approach for children and 21 families.
