BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3701.147 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 3701.147. (A) The department of health, in	7
coordination with the department of aging, the commission on	8
minority health, and community organizations focusing on	9
Alzheimer's disease and other types of dementia awareness, shall	10
incorporate awareness information into relevant public health	11
outreach conducted by the department of health.	12
(B) The parties described in division (A) of this section	13
shall design the information to educate and increase awareness	14
and understanding among health care providers, community	15
organizations, and the general public on the following topics	16
related to cognitive impairment, Alzheimer's disease, and other	17
types of dementia:	18
