As used in this section "nonprofit organization" means an entity organized pursuant to the law of this state or which is authorized to conduct nonprofit activity in this state and a majority of its members are comprised of certified teachers or other music education service providers who, whether music education is their exclusive area of responsibility or the teacher or other education service providers provide or assist in providing instruction in other areas and subjects, and are primarily engaged

- in providing music instruction to students in grades one (1) through
  twelve (12), or who provide instruction in connection with a student
  band or orchestra supported in whole or in part by funds of the
  school district, or both such functions.
  - B. It shall be unlawful for a nonprofit organization as defined by subsection A of this section to require its members to join, support, become a member of, or to pay dues or membership fees to any other nonprofit organization as a condition of joining or remaining a member in good standing of the nonprofit organization.
  - C. The provisions of this section shall be applicable with respect to the persons who are members of a nonprofit organization as defined by subsection A of this section as of the effective date of this act.
  - SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
