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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3648.1 of Title 68, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. There is hereby created until July 1, 2029, an investment
18	rebate program for the cost of water and wastewater infrastructure
19	investments by municipalities with a population between five
20	thousand (5,000) and seven thousand (7,000), according to the latest
21	Federal Decennial Census.
22	B. To be eligible for consideration for an investment rebate
23	payment awarded under the provisions of this act, the municipality
24	shall:

 Department of Commerce, as required by the Department, outlining the
 planned water and wastewater infrastructure expenditures of at least
 Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00);

2. Provide documentation that the water and wastewater
infrastructure expenditures are to provide services for an
establishment, to be placed in service after the effective date of
this act, that is defined or classified in the NAICS Manual under
Industry Group No. 721211 or 71311 and whose combined capital
investment exceeds One Hundred Million Dollars (\$100,000,000.00);

3. Provide documentation that the water and wastewater
 infrastructure expenditures are to provide services for an
 establishment within an incentive or increment district formed
 pursuant to the Local Development Act, Section 850 et seq. of Title
 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

4. Have made expenditures of no less than twenty percent (20%)
of the water and wastewater infrastructure expenditure plan outlined
in the application submitted by the municipality.

C. 1. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall approve or
 disapprove claims for rebates and shall issue payment for all
 approved claims from funds held in the Water Infrastructure for
 Economic Development Fund created in Section 2 of this act.

23 2. The Department shall disapprove all applications and claims24 or any portion of applications and claims for rebates that would

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exceed the balance of available funds in the Water Infrastructure
 for Economic Development Fund.

3 3. The total amount of applications approved and investment 4 rebate payments awarded under the provisions of this act shall not 5 exceed the total amount of monies designated by law for deposit to 6 the Water Infrastructure for Economic Development Fund.

D. 1. Subject to the approval and ongoing review of the eligibility application by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, the investment rebate payment authorized by this act shall be equal to the cost of the water and wastewater infrastructure expenditures in the year of expenditure, not to exceed Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00) for any municipality.

2. The Department is authorized to conditionally prequalify and 13 account for anticipated future investment rebate payments. 14 The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall not prequalify investment 15 rebate payments, encumber funds, pre-encumber funds, or otherwise 16 allocate resources that would result in the allocation of investment 17 rebate payments in excess of the balance of available funds in the 18 Water Infrastructure for Economic Development Fund. 19

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3648.2 of Title 68, unless there 22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund for theOklahoma Department of Commerce to be designated the "Water

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1	Infrastructure for Economic Development Fund". The fund shall be a
2	continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
3	consist of all monies designated for deposit to the fund by law.
4	All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
5	appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for
6	the purpose of paying rebates as provided by this act. Expenditures
7	from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
8	Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
9	Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
10	approval and payment.
11	B. All unencumbered funds remaining in the Water Infrastructure
12	for Economic Development Fund upon July 1, 2029, shall be
13	transferred to the State Treasurer for deposit in the General
14	Revenue Fund.
15	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
16	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
18	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
