19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 401 of Title 73, unless there is
22	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority shall allocate
24	the sum of Four Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars

1 (\$4,300,000.00) from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund for purposes 2 of the design and construction of the State Capitol Arch the purpose of which is to honor and memorialize the services performed by the 3 Oklahoma National Guard. 4

5 Β. The State Capitol Arch shall be constructed upon the following described parcel of real property: 6

The State Capitol Preservation Commission shall enter into 8 9 contract with such person, persons, or lawfully recognized entities 10 as may be required in order to construct the State Capitol Arch according to preliminary design documents as prepared by the 11 12 Architect of the State Capitol.

13 The provisions of Section 187B of Title 73 of the Oklahoma D. 14 Statutes shall be applicable to the project.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and

19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
