15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
17	last amended by Section 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
18	2015, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
20	authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
21	plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
22	financial assistance as provided by this section.
23	Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
24	person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of

ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

4 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 5 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 6 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 7 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 8 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 9 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 10 issued on a staggered system.

The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 11 12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept applications for special license plates authorized under this 13 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 14 15 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 16 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary information directly into such system and generate a receipt 17 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 19 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 22

If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 1 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 2 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 3 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 4 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 5 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 6 removed from the vehicle.

7 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax 8 9 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid 10 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by 11 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the 12 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are 13 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 14 15 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

23 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
24 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in 2 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 3 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide general public environmental education program created pursuant to 4 5 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination 6 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 7 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued 8 9 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated 10 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee 11 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by 12 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned 13 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title; 14

15 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed 16 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four 17 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a 18 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 19 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. 20 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 21 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 22 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 23 24 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may

apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire department by either an identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

11 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be 12 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 13 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 14 15 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in 16 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may 17 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license 18 19 plates.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
 the prevention of child abuse.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collectedshall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

7 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 8 9 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The 10 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 11 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 12 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States 13 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United 14 15 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or 16 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not 17 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate 18 issued: 19

7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
 Oklahoma;

9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates 14 15 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency 16 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 17 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical 18 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in 19 20 consultation with the state association of emergency medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 21 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician 22 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63 23 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 24

11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
 Revolving Fund;

Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 6 12. 7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates 8 9 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims 10 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 11 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for 12 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to 13 provide services to crime victims; 14

Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates 15 13. 16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The 17 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 18 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of 19 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -20 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to 21 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program; 22

14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the

Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.4 of this title;

7 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 8 9 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 10 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued 11 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag 12 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an 13 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.3 of this title; 14

15 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates 16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate 17 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 18 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As 19 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 20 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial 21 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of 22 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 23

1 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 3 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to 4 5 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate 6 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three 7 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as 8 9 follows: 10 five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education a. Reform Revolving Fund, 11 12 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher Education Revolving Fund, 13 five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State 14 с. 15 Career Technology Fund, and eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be 16 d. deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as 17 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the 18 Oklahoma Statutes. 19 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a 20 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial 21 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be 22 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this 23 24 paragraph;

1 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of 3 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the 4 5 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate 6 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in 7 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or 8 9 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown. 10 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 11 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 12 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the 13 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 14 15 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this 16 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the 17 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund; 18

19 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
22 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
23 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
24 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.

The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the 8 9 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 10 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state 11 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and 12 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of 13 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5 14 15 of this title;

Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates 16 21. shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 17 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and 18 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 19 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee 20 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation 21 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and 22 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks; 23

1 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates 2 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of 3 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and wishing to provide assistance to quardians, adoptive 4 5 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates 6 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation 7 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human 8 9 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall 10 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury 11 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the 12 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act 13 specifically for created families;

23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed, 14 15 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life, 16 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women 17 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount 18 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life 19 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of 20 this title; 21

22 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall 23 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 24 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The 1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 2 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an 3 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 4 Section 1104.7 of this title;

5 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed 6 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions 7 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, 8 9 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be 10 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation 11 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association 12 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service 13 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to 14 Foundation. the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars 15 16 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 18 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person 19 20 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's 21 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section, 22 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 23 Section 1104.8 of this title; 24

1 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter 2 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any 3 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person 4 5 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of 6 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. 7 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a 8 9 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of 10 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use 11 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The 12 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout 13 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 14 15 plate issued;

Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such 16 28. plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 17 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. 18 The plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City 19 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter 20 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon 21 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the 22 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing 23 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial 24

1 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 2 plate issued;

29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

8 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed 9 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. 10 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The 11 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the 12 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be 13 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma 14 15 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

16 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for 17 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational 18 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in 19 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty 20 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the 21 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet 22 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the 23

Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
 Section 1104.10 of this title;

3 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to 4 5 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active 6 7 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination duty. of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 8 9 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion 10 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title; 11

12 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma 13 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma 14 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States 15 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on 16 17 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. 18 As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be 19 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in 20 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 21

34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The

1 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 2 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 3 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls 4 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter 5 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America 6 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the 7 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of 8 9 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 10 plate issued;

11 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall 12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support 13 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be 14 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse 15 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee 16 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving 17 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such 18 36. plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 19 20 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. 21 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and 22 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license 23 24 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

3 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 4 5 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section, 6 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma 7 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this 8 9 title;

10 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued 11 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes 12 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects, 13 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes. 14 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 15 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and 16 17 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title; Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates 18 39. shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 19 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be 20 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from 21 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official 22 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark 23 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. 24 The Tax

Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

7 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support 8 9 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization 10 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal 11 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and 12 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military 13 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan. 14 15 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. Prevent Blindness Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support 13 for vision screening of school age children in this state. 14 The 15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with Prevent Blindness Oklahoma. As provided in this section, an amount of the 16 fee collected shall be deposited in the Prevent Blindness Oklahoma 17 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.17 of this 18 title; 19

45. Oklahoma State Capitol Restoration License Plate - such
plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
demonstrate support for restoration of the Oklahoma State Capitol
building. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
the Friends of the Capitol corporation, created pursuant to Section

1 15.4 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the State Capitol 2 Preservation Commission created pursuant to Section 4102 of Title 74 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes. As provided in this section, an amount of 4 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Friends of the 5 Capitol License Plate Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.18 6 of this title;

7 46. Eastern Red Cedar Tree License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 8 9 Commission and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support 10 for the removal of Eastern Red Cedar trees from lands in the state 11 and to develop marketable uses for the harvested trees. The license 12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Eastern Red Cedar Registry Board. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected 13 shall be deposited in the Eastern Red Cedar Revolving Fund created 14 in Section 18-407 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate - such plates 18 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support 19 for the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer 20 Research Fund. The plates shall be issued to any person in any 21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. 22 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 23 University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund. 24

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be 4 5 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the 6 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates 7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of 8 9 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research 10 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this 11 title;

12 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support 13 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. 14 The 15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. As provided in this 16 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the 17 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in 18 Section 1104.21 of this title; 19

Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be 2 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for a vehicle or motorcycle 3 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of 4 5 seven, as for personalized plates. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of 6 7 Police. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space 8 9 requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The Tax Commission 10 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the 11 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for any licensing fees 12 which may be required in order to use the association's logo or 13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police of not more than Twenty 14 15 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Chiefs of Police 16 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015; 17 Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates 18 54. shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 19 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City. 20 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 21 administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission 22 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with 23 Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be 24

1 required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing 2 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian 3 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 4 plate issued;

5 55. Hilldale Education Foundation License Plates - such plates 6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 7 support for the Hilldale Education Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of the 8 9 Hilldale Education Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be 10 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Hilldale 11 Education Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in 12 order to use the foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Hilldale Education 13 Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 14 15 plate issued;

56. Oklahoma Nurses License Plate - such plates shall be issued 16 to any person licensed pursuant to the Oklahoma Nursing Practice Act 17 and providing such documentation of current licensure as may be 18 required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The license plates shall 19 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Nurses Association. 20 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 21 deposited in the Oklahoma Nurses License Plate Revolving Fund 22 created in Section 1104.26 of this title; 23

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 6 collected shall be deposited in the Educational Television Authority Revolving Fund created in Section 156 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma 7 Statutes; and 8

9 57. 58. Remembering Fallen Heroes License Plate - such plates 10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. Such plates shall be 11 12 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapter of Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. As provided in this section, an amount of 13 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Concerns of 14 15 Police Survivors License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 3 16 of this act;

59. A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma (ABATE) 17 License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any person wishing to 18 provide financial support for the ABATE of Oklahoma Foundation. 19 The 20 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the ABATE of Oklahoma Foundation. 15	C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
16	(\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
17	provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The

5 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 52 O.S. 2011, Section 288.7, as
6 amended by Section 215, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (52 O.S. Supp.
7 2015, Section 288.7), is amended to read as follows:

Section 288.7. A. There is hereby created in the State 8 9 Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board to 10 be designated the "Energy Resources Revolving Fund". The fund shall 11 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations and 12 shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board from assessments received and collected pursuant to 13 Section 288.8A of this title, donations, grants, contributions and 14 15 gifts from any public or private source and monies deposited 16 pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The Board may expend funds as provided for by 17 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued 18 law. by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law 19 with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 20 Services for approval and payment. 21

B. Of the monies collected and not refunded pursuant to
Sections 288.8A and 288.9A of this title, a minimum of fifty percent
(50%) of said monies collected, including a prorated share of

administrative costs incurred from the effective date of this act, and not subsequently refunded, shall be expended on environmental cleanup and remediation projects related to oil and gas pollution authorized by the Board from a priority list of projects submitted by the Corporation Commission or, only in the absence of Corporation Commission jurisdiction, projects submitted by other appropriate state agencies.

8 C. None of the monies collected and not refunded pursuant to 9 Sections 288.8A and 288.9A of this title shall be used for travel 10 expenses of any member of the Oklahoma Legislature.

11 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.28 of Title 47, unless 13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for A Brotherhood Aiming
Toward Education of Oklahoma (ABATE) license plates shall be
deposited to the ABATE of Oklahoma License Plate Revolving Fund
created in subsection B of this section.

B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety to be designated the "ABATE of Oklahoma License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall consist of all monies received pursuant to subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma

1	Department of Public Safety for the purpose of providing grants to
2	the ABATE of Oklahoma Foundation for programs to promote its
3	mission. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants
4	issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
5	law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
6	Services for approval and payment.
7	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
