15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. 1. After the effective date of this act, a natural asset
17	company shall not purchase or maintain any land in this state for
18	the sole purpose of managing these areas for conservation,
19	restoration, or sustainable management.
20	2. The state, county, or a political subdivision shall not
21	adopt a procurement, investment, or other policy that may encourage
22	any financial investment for a natural asset company in this state.
