AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, providing 5 for attendance at intermediate units. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a section to read: 11 12 Section 1327.4. Attendance at Intermediate Units.--(a) An 13 intermediate unit shall establish an attendance policy designed to accurately determine attendance for a child who is enrolled 14 15 in a school district and receives a portion of the child's
- 16 <u>education from the intermediate unit.</u>
- 17 <u>(b) The policy under subsection (a) shall address how the</u>
- 18 intermediate unit:
- 19 (1) coordinates procedures with the school district when a
- 20 child is truant under section 1333;

- 1 (2) participates in the school attendance improvement
- 2 conference under section 1333(b); and
- 3 (3) coordinates procedures with the school district when a
- 4 <u>child is habitually truant under section 1333.1.</u>
- 5 (c) If an intermediate unit provides all or substantially
- 6 <u>all of a student's education, the intermediate unit shall be</u>
- 7 responsible for all truancy procedures under sections 1333.1 and
- 8 1333.
- 9 (d) If an intermediate unit provides all or substantially
- 10 all of a student's education under a contract with a school
- 11 district, the contract shall include the manner in which funding
- 12 shall be required if the student is habitually truant under
- 13 section 1333.1.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
