AN ACT

- Designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 310 between Knox Dale Road, also known as State Route 2023, and Ash Street in
- McCalmont Township, Jefferson County, as the Lance Cpl.
- Bernard Himes Memorial Highway.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Lance Cpl. Bernard Himes Memorial Highway.
- 8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) Bernard Malcolm Himes was born November 25, 1949, in
- 11 Anita, Jefferson County.
- 12 (2) Mr. Himes was a student at Punxsutawney Area High
- 13 School. At the time of his graduation, he was 17 years of
- 14 age, which was too young to join the military without
- 15 parental consent. He presented his parents with the
- 16 documentation needed to enlist in the United States Marine
- 17 Corps and they signed.
- 18 (3) Mr. Himes was a member of I Company, 3rd Battalion,

- 1 27th Marines, 1st Marine Division, III Marine Expeditionary
- 2 Force.
- 3 (4) Upon Mr. Himes' promotion to Lance Corporal, he was
- 4 deployed to Vietnam.
- 5 (5) On May 17, 1968, almost one year after his high
- 6 school graduation, Lance Corporal Himes was killed in action
- 7 on Go Noi Island in South Vietnam.
- 8 (6) For his valiant service, Lance Corporal Himes'
- 9 parents, Reed and Phyllis Himes, were presented with his
- 10 Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, National
- 11 Defense Service Medal, Gallantry Cross with Palm, Military
- 12 Merit Medal and Purple Heart.
- 13 (b) Designation. -- The section of Pennsylvania Route 310
- 14 between Knox Dale Road, also known as State Route 2023, and Ash
- 15 Street in McCalmont Township, Jefferson County, is designated
- 16 the Lance Cpl. Bernard Himes Memorial Highway.
- 17 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 18 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 19 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 20 Section 2. Effective date.
- 21 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
