AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled, as
 2 reenacted, "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and
 3 malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating
 4 and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and
 5 restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession,
 6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding
 7 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic
 8 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the
 9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and
 10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing
 11 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores,
 12 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective
 13 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain
 14 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure
 15 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures;
 16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in
 17 distilleries, wineries, bonded warehouses, bailees for hire
 18 and transporters for hire, further providing for exemptions.

19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 20 hereby enacts as follows:

21 Section 1. Section 502 of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90,
 22 No.21), known as the Liquor Code, reenacted and amended June 29,
 23 1987 (P.L.32, No.14) and amended June 30, 1992 (P.L.327, No.66),
 24 is amended to read:

25 Section 502. Exemptions.--No license hereunder shall be

1 required from any registered pharmacist; or a physician licensed
2 by the State Board of Medicine; or any person who makes and
3 sells vinegar, nonalcoholic cider and fruit juices; or any
4 person who manufactures, stores, sells or transports methanol,
5 propanol, butanol and amanol; or any person who conducts a
6 wholesale drug business; or any person who manufactures
7 alcoholic preparations not fit for use as a beverage, other than
8 denatured alcohol or for beverage purposes; any person engaged
9 in the manufacture; possession or sale of patent, patented or
10 proprietary medicines, toilet, medicinal or antiseptic
11 preparations unfit for beverage purposes, or solutions or
12 flavoring extracts or syrups unfit for beverage purposes; or any
13 person who manufactures or sells paints, varnishes, enamels,
14 lacquers, stains or paint, or varnish removing or reducing
15 compounds, or wood fillers; or any person who manufactures any
16 substance where the alcohol or any liquor is changed into other
17 chemical substances and does not appear in the finished product
18 as alcohol or liquor; or any common carrier by railroad which is
19 subject to regulation by the Pennsylvania Public Utility
20 Commission of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or scheduled
21 common carriers by air of mail and passengers; or any person who
22 sells, stores or transports alcohol or liquor completely
23 denatured, as specified by the board; or any person licensed
24 under Article IV for malt and brewed beverages who manufactures,
25 distills or otherwise produces alcohol as a byproduct of the
26 manufacture of any reduced alcohol or nonalcohol malt or brewed
27 beverage if the byproduct is not intended nor used as a beverage
28 for human consumption except as part of the malt or brewed
29 beverage; or any person who distills alcohol or liquor for
30 personal use only and not for sale.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
