## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, 1 No.1), entitled "An act providing for taxation by school districts, for the State funds formula, for tax relief in first class cities, for school district choice and voter participation, for other school district options and for a 5 task force on school cost reduction; making an appropriation; 6 prohibiting prior authorized taxation; providing for 7 installment payment of taxes; restricting the power of 8 certain school districts to levy, assess and collect taxes; 9 and making related repeals," in preliminary provisions, 10 further providing for definitions; and, in taxation by school 11 districts, further providing for school district tax notices. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 102 of the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp. Sess., P.L. 1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, is 16 17 amended by adding a definition to read: Section 102. Definitions. 18 19 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 20 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 21 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 "Conspicuous." A term, written, displayed or presented in a
- 2 manner that a reasonable person against which the term is to
- 3 operate should have noticed. Conspicuous terms shall include the
- 4 <u>following:</u>
- 5 <u>(1) A heading in capitals:</u>
- 6 (i) greater in size than the surrounding text; and
- 7 <u>(ii) in contrasting type, font or color to the</u>
- 8 <u>surrounding text of lesser size.</u>
- 9 (2) Language in the body of a record or display:
- 10 (i) greater in size than the surrounding text;
- 11 (ii) in contrasting type or font to the surrounding
- 12 <u>text of the same size;</u>
- 13 <u>(iii) in black type against a solid yellow</u>
- 14 <u>background; and</u>
- 15 <u>(iv) set off from surrounding text of the same size</u>
- by symbols or other marks that call attention to the
- language.

- 19 Section 2. Section 343 of the act is amended to read:
- 20 Section 343. School district tax notices.
- 21 (a) Tax notice. -- A school district that implements homestead
- 22 and farmstead exclusions shall itemize the homestead and
- 23 farmstead exclusion on tax bills sent to homestead and farmstead
- 24 owners, indicating the original amount of tax liability, the
- 25 amount of the exclusion and the net amount of tax due after the
- 26 exclusion is applied. The tax bill shall be easily
- 27 understandable and include a notice pursuant to subsection (b).
- 28 (b) Notice of [property tax relief] State Gaming Fund tax
- 29 rebate REDUCTION. -- A school district that implements homestead
- 30 and farmstead exclusions shall include with the homestead or

- 1 farmstead owner's tax bill a notice that the tax bill includes a
- 2 homestead or farmstead exclusion in the amount identified under
- 3 subsection (a). The notice shall at a minimum be conspicuous and
- 4 take the following form:
- 5 [NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX RELIEF
- Your enclosed tax bill includes a tax reduction for your
- 7 homestead and/or farmstead property. As an eligible homestead
- and/or farmstead property owner, you have received tax relief
- 9 through a homestead and/or farmstead exclusion which has been
- 10 provided under the Pennsylvania Taxpayer Relief Act, a law
- passed by the Pennsylvania General Assembly designed to
- reduce your property taxes.]
- 13 STATE GAMING FUND TAX REBATE REDUCTION
- 14 Your enclosed tax bill includes a tax reduction of (amount of

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- exclusion) for your property. You received this tax relief
- through a homestead and/or farmstead exclusion funded by the <--
- 17 gaming industry GAMING REVENUE and provided under the
- 18 Pennsylvania Taxpayer Relief Act, a law passed by the
- 19 Pennsylvania General Assembly designed to reduce your
- 20 property taxes. This reduction is separate from any tax
- 21 increase or additional tax reduction ACTION TAKEN by your <--
- 22 school district.
- 23 Section 3. The amendment of sections 102 and 343 of the act
- 24 shall apply to taxable years beginning after December 31, <del>2022</del>
- 25 2023.
- 26 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
