AN ACT

Amending the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.637, No.329), entitled 1 "An act relating to the payment of wages or compensation for 2 labor or services; providing for regular pay days; conferring 3 powers and duties upon the Department of Labor and Industry, 4 including powers and duties with respect to the civil 5 collection of wages; providing civil and criminal penalties 6 for violations of the act; providing for their collection and 7 disposition and providing for additional civil damages," 8 expanding the scope of the act. 9 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 2.1 of the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.637, 13 No.329), known as the Wage Payment and Collection Law, added 14 July 14, 1977 (P.L.82, No.30), is amended to read: 15 Section 2.1. Definitions. -- The following words and phrases 16 when used in this act shall have, unless the context clearly 17 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section: 18 "Authorized representative." An employe of the Department of Labor and Industry who is empowered to perform duties assigned 19 in conformity with all existing laws, rules and regulations 20

1 administered by the department.

2 "Check." A draft drawn on a bank and payable on demand. "Department." The Department of Labor and Industry. 3 "Employer." Includes the Commonwealth; any of its political <--4 subdivisions; any authority created by the General Assembly and 5 any instrumentality or agency of the Commonwealth; every person, 6 7 firm, partnership, association, corporation, receiver or other 8 officer of a court of this Commonwealth and any agent or officer of any of the above-mentioned classes employing any person in 9 10 this Commonwealth AND INCLUDES A PUBLIC BODY. <---11 "Fringe benefits or wage supplements." Includes all monetary 12 employer payments to provide benefits under any employe benefit 13 plan, as defined in section 3(3) of the Employee Retirement 14 Income Security Act of 1974, 29 U.S.C. § 1001 et seq.; as well 15 as separation, vacation, holiday, or guaranteed pay; 16 reimbursement for expenses; union dues withheld from the employes' pay by the employer; and any other amount to be paid 17 18 pursuant to an agreement to the employe, a third party or fund 19 for the benefit of employes. 20 "PUBLIC BODY." THE COMMONWEALTH AND A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. <--

21 THE TERM INCLUDES ANY OFFICER, BOARD, COMMISSION, AGENCY,

22 AUTHORITY OR OTHER INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE COMMONWEALTH OR A

24 "Secretary." The Secretary of Labor and Industry.

Wages." Includes all earnings of an employe, regardless of whether determined on time, task, piece, commission or other method of calculation. The term "wages" also includes fringe benefits or wage supplements whether payable by the employer from his funds or from amounts withheld from the employes' pay by the employer.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
