## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for exemption to COVID-19 vaccine requirement.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Short title.
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the COVID-19
- 6 Vaccine Exemption Options Act.
- 7 Section 2. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "COVID-19." The coronavirus disease 2019, an infectious
- 12 disease caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus
- 13 2 that was first identified during December 2019 in Wuhan,
- 14 China.
- "COVID-19 vaccine." A vaccine for COVID-19 that has received
- 16 an emergency use authorization or approval from the United
- 17 States Food and Drug Administration.
- "Government entity." The Governor, a State agency, a State

- 1 board or commission, the General Assembly, a legislative agency,
- 2 a court of the Commonwealth or any other entity or office of the
- 3 unified judicial system, a county executive or a governing body
- 4 of a political subdivision.
- 5 "Place of public accommodation." A facility or location that
- 6 is open to the public without regard to whether a member of the
- 7 public intends to purchase an item or procure a service at the
- 8 facility or location.
- 9 "Political subdivision." A county, city, borough,
- 10 incorporated town, township, school district, intermediate unit,
- 11 vocational school district or county institution district.
- 12 "Private entity." A for-profit or not-for-profit entity or
- 13 organization that is open to the public at large or operates a
- 14 workplace for employees of the entity or organization.
- 15 Section 3. Exemption to COVID-19 vaccine requirement.
- 16 Except as otherwise provided under Federal law, a private
- 17 entity, government entity or place of public accommodation that
- 18 is required by a State or local regulation, order, ordinance or
- 19 other directive to impose a COVID-19 vaccine requirement on any
- 20 employee, customer, patron, client, agent, invitee, patient or
- 21 other individual may exempt the same from the COVID-19 vaccine
- 22 requirement if the employee, customer, patron, client, agent,
- 23 invitee, patient or other individual furnishes any of the
- 24 following:
- 25 (1) Proof from a physician of being previously infected
- 26 with COVID-19 within one year from the date when the COVID-19
- 27 vaccine requirement applies to the individual.
- 28 (2) Serology test results verifying that the individual
- 29 possesses COVID-19 antibodies.
- 30 (3) Negative test results from a COVID-19 test.

- 1 Section 4. Construction.
- Nothing in this act shall be construed to affect the
- 3 authority of a State agency, State official, local governing
- 4 body or local official to issue or enact a State or local
- 5 regulation, order, ordinance or other directive to impose a
- 6 COVID-19 vaccine requirement of any kind.
- 7 Section 5. Expiration.
- 8 This act shall expire November 30, 2023.
- 9 Section 6. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect immediately.
