## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, in sex trafficking and missing and
- abducted children, further providing for county
- 4 responsibilities; and making an editorial change.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 5702 heading and (c) of Title 23 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section
- 9 is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 10 § 5702. County and department responsibilities.
- 11 \* \* \*
- 12 (c) Report to department.--[The county agency shall report
- 13 annually to the department the total number of children who are
- 14 sex trafficking victims. The report shall be submitted in the
- 15 form and by the deadline prescribed by the department.] A county
- 16 agency shall report annually to the department the following
- 17 information in the form and by the deadline prescribed by the
- 18 department:

- 1 (1) The total number of children who are sex trafficking
- 2 victims.
- 3 (2) The total number of children who have been reported
- 4 <u>missing under subsection (b) and whether or not the child has</u>
- 5 <u>been subsequently located.</u>
- 6 (3) The total number of children who have been
- 7 <u>identified</u>, screened and assessed as possible sex trafficking
- 8 <u>victims by the county agency.</u>
- 9 (d) Department responsibilities.--The department shall
- 10 report annually the information received from a county agency
- 11 <u>under subsection (c) to the following:</u>
- 12 (1) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 13 Aging and Youth Committee of the Senate.
- 14 (2) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 15 Children and Youth Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 16 (3) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 17 Judiciary Committee of the Senate.
- 18 (4) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- Judiciary Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 20 Section 2. Section 5703 of Title 23 is amended to read:
- 21 § 5703. Law enforcement responsibilities.
- 22 When law enforcement receives information from a county
- 23 agency about a child who is missing from the child's residence
- 24 or is abducted under section 5702(b) (relating to county and
- 25 department responsibilities), law enforcement shall enter the
- 26 information into the National Crime Information Center database.
- 27 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
