A LOTTERY GAME IN WHICH, BY THE USE 8 OF A COMPUTER, TABLET COMPUTER OR OTHER MOBILE DEVICE, A PLAYER 9 REMOVES THE COVERING FROM RANDOMLY GENERATED NUMBERS OR LETTERS 10 WHICH REVEAL WHETHER THE INSTANT TICKET IS A WINNING TICKET FOR WHICH MONEY IS PAID. A PLAYER SHALL NOT INCLUDE A RETAILER WHO <--11 12 SELLS OR PURCHASES TICKETS THROUGH THE LOTTERY CENTRAL COMPUTER. 13 "KENO." A LOTTERY GAME COMMONLY KNOWN AS KENO. 25 Section 303. Powers and duties of secretary.

(a) Powers and duties enumerated.--In addition to the powers
and duties provided by law and the act of April 9, 1929
(P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, the
secretary shall have the power and it shall be his duty to
operate and administer the lottery, and to promulgate rules and

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regulations governing the establishment and operation thereof,
 including, but not limited to:

17 (iv) for property tax relief and free or reduced 18 fare transit service for the elderly as provided in 19 section 311. For fiscal years beginning before July 1, 20 [2015] 2014, no less than 27% of the total revenues 21 accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares shall 22 be dedicated to this subparagraph. For fiscal years 23 beginning after June 30, [2015] 2014, no less than [30%] 24 25% of the total revenues accruing from the sale of 25 lottery tickets or shares shall be dedicated to this 26 subparagraph.

6 Section 315. Report.

7 The Department of Revenue shall submit a report to the Governor, the chairman and minority chairman of the 8 Appropriations Committee of the Senate, the chairman and 9 10 minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House 11 of Representatives, the chairman and minority chairman of the 12 Aging and Youth Committee of the Senate [and], the chairman and 13 minority chairman of the Aging and Older Adult Services 14 Committee of the House of Representatives, the chairman and minority chairman of the Finance Committee of the Senate and the 15 16 chairman and minority chairman of the Finance Committee of the House of Representatives by [June 1] September 1 of each year. 17 18 The report shall set forth current lottery profits and the State 19 Lottery's plan for increasing future profits. This report shall 20 be posted on the department's publicly accessible Internet 21 website. [This section shall expire June 30, 2015.] 22 Section 2 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
