1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16	Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled, as reenacted, "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, for the payment of certain license fees to the respective municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; providing for local option, and repealing existing laws,"

19	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
20	hereby enacts as follows:
21	Section 1. Section 410(e) of the act of April 12, 1951
22	(P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, reenacted and amended
23	June 29, 1987 (P.L.32, No.14), is amended to read:
24	Section 410. Liquor Importers' Licenses; Fees; Privileges;
25	Restrictions* * *

1 (1) Importers' licenses shall permit the holders (e) 2 thereof to bring or import liquor from other states, foreign 3 countries, or insular possessions of the United States, and purchase liquor from manufacturers located within this 4 Commonwealth, to be sold outside of this Commonwealth or to 5 Pennsylvania Liquor Stores within this Commonwealth, or when in 6 7 original containers of ten gallons or greater capacity, to licensed manufacturers within this Commonwealth. 8 9 (2) Importing distributors that import liquor from a foreign 10 country through a port located in this Commonwealth shall receive from Pennsylvania Liquor Stores a bonus of two per 11 centum of the wholesale price of the imported liquor sold to 12 13 Pennsylvania Liquor Stores. 14 (3) All importations of liquor into Pennsylvania by the licensed importer shall be consigned to the board or the 15 principal place of business or authorized place of storage 16 17 maintained by the licensee.
